Vineyards The constant year-round sunshine of our organically grown Verdejo vineyard helps us to produce richly aromatic, ripe and healthy grapes with crisp acidity.

Varieties 100% Ecological Verdejo

Soils Clay and lime soils with fiercely cold winters and hot, dry summers.

Wine-making Certified by SOHISCERT (SHC) *Certificación Agroalimentaria*.

Only the very finest grapes were hand-selected from our sorting table and fermented slowly in stainless-steel tanks, at a controlled temperature of 20°-22°C. This careful and non-intrusive process allows us to ensure optimum aroma, flavour and balance. The process also means the total production is strictly limited according to the quality of each vintage. The wine is bottled to order, to maintain maximum freshness for our customers.

The viticulture is 100% ECOLOGICALLY CERTIFIED, which means that there is no chemical intervention in the vineyards – no artificial pesticides, herbicides, or fertilisers are used on the vines.

Tasting Notes VERANEO is richly floral, with a vibrant zesty core. The enviable crispness, flavour and balance make VERANEO an elegant and refreshing wine, and the subtle hints of peach and lemon lead to a gloriously long and pleasant aftertaste.

Food Pairing VERANEO is great with salads, grilled chicken (it is perfect for a summer BBQ, for example), and wonderful with tapas and seafood – *paella*, *gambas*, deep-fried squid...

Winemaker's Guide The wine is ready to enjoy now and best enjoyed young – over the next two years – while its brilliant, zesty flavours are in their pomp. Serve well chilled – between 7°C and 9°C – as a cool aperitif.
