D.O.P. Campo de Borja: Cosecha 2018

Thanks to the great annual weather conditions in 2017/2018, the production levels were very generous (+82% vs the previous year). The combination of abundant winter and spring rainfall (+ 530 L/m²) and the absence of frost and hail, led to good grape health with no mildew problems, excellent flowering and fruit formation. In fact, April was probably the wettest April in the history of DO Campo de Borja, at 169.4 L/m².

The summer was not as hot as the previous year and very dry, with practically no rainfall from the end of June, which greatly favoured the production of the grapes. Average temperature during the wine year was 14.0°C and the average yield of this harvest was 6,921.01 kg/ha.
